Positive Notice Blue Card

All Adult members will be required to have a current Positive Notice Blue Card prior to commencement with the Revue.

As applications for the Card can take some time, early receipt of your application form will greatly assist. Application forms are available from our Web site or from the Personnel Director.

Please allow enough time for the Blue Card application to be processed (currently 6-8 weeks).

Snacks and light meals will be available for purchase at the canteen for a nominal cost during the rehearsal period and before shows.

CAST APPLICANTS

Who Can Apply?

Application for cast is open to any registered, Uniform, Financial member of Scouts Australia – Queensland Branch Inc aged 10 and above (as at Final Night) who are prepared to participate in Wonargo Revue in addition to their regular Scouting activities.

Consideration will be given in the first instance to members under 26 years of age, and are members of Brisbane's North Side and/or who do not have another Scout Show in their local area.

CLOSING DATE FOR CAST

Applications for cast must be received by the **25th April 2011**. **Applications for Cast are unable to be accepted after this date** so don't delay in returning your application.

Costumes

You will be required to supply some items at your own personal expense. Eg correct flesh coloured underwear, dance supports for mature males, stockings for mature females, shoes etc. Further details will be provided closer to the show.

The New Scout Uniform (Dress Shirt & Scout Belt) is required for the show.

REHEARSAL DETAILS

Rehearsals will be **12.00pm – 5.30pm on Sundays** at the Wonargo Cultural Centre, Flower St, Northgate. Specific Rehearsals **Tuesday 7.00pm - 9.00pm** You will be advised in advanced if you are required.

There will be 2 Rehearsal camps.

Please study the Wonargo Diary attached to ensure you are aware of the commitment you are making.

AUDITIONS

All cast applicants will be required to audition for inclusion in the Cast.

You will be required to sing a section of a song to Piano Accompaniment. A selection of material will be provided at the Auditions or you may bring your own Piano sheet music.

You will also be required to perform a section of a sketch or reading. You may choose a piece from the material provided or you may bring along your own selection.

The Audition process should take approximately 25 minutes and will be held at the Wonargo Cultural Centre, Flower Street Northgate (next to the Toombul Bowls Club).

Auditions will not be based upon talent alone. Audition criteria will also include Appearance, Attitude, Presentation (of self and uniform), previous years Attendance and Behaviour, and Service to the Revue.

Your full correct uniform is required to be worn to the Auditions. Your photo will be taken for inclusion in the program at auditions.

You will be judged on your presentation of uniform.

COSTS

The Activity fee is \$80 applicable to each accepted cast member. The activity fee will cover the costs of the two camps, the Activity fee, meals during the all day rehearsals and before final night show, and interval refreshments during the shows.

If the activity fee is not received (or a payment plan not agreed) by the due date, acceptance into the cast will be withdrawn.

The due date will be first rehearsal.

SUPPORT SECTION **APPLICANTS**

There are many opportunities to help as part of a team in the Support areas. The Support areas consist of Parents, Scout Members and friends who are prepared to help the youth of our movement and uphold the principles of scouting.

The support areas offer a wide variety of interesting activities. These sections include:

- **Back stage Crew** / Set Design / Set Construction / Sound / Lighting / Small Props
- **Wardrobe** / Costumes / Sewing / Make Up / Wigs
- **Promotions** / Front of House / Ticket Sales
- **Personnel** / Welfare / Canteen

These sections meet at various times and locations throughout the Revue Season. Some teams require you to be 18 years old or over.

On receipt of your application form, you will be contacted by your Team Leader for information on when your team will be meeting. It is expected that all Supporters will assist with the Bump in and Bump out of the Theatre of their respective areas.

CLOSING DATE FOR SUPPORT

Application forms for all support areas must be **received** before the **18th September** to allow for all relevant paper work to be completed prior to the show and to allow your inclusion in and completion of the Program.
